I. INTRODUCTION

Children & Family Services is responsible to:

- A. Serve vulnerable children removed from parental care for abuse and neglect, multidisciplinary professionals work together at all levels for the benefit of children taken into protective custody.
- B. Ensure that children receiving child welfare services and who have been identified as needing prescriptions for medical care will have those prescriptions filled in a timely manner.

II. BACKGROUND

Walgreens is a nationwide retail pharmacy chain where patient care, medication safety and convenience are the cornerstones of their pharmacy services. With advance authorization, Foster Parents/caregivers/Social Workers will have access to Walgreens prescription drug program to facilitate obtaining prescription medications for those children entering and/or placed in the foster care system that have been evaluated by a medical physician and have been prescribed medications that are needed for their care. In those instances where a foster child's Medi-Cal card is pending or where a prescribed medication is not covered, Walgreens pharmacies will fill these prescriptions on an emergency basis to ensure that the medical needs of children in out-of-home care are met.

III. **POLICY**

If a child is prescribed medication that requires that it be filled on an emergency basis, CFS staff will take the prescription and a Contra Costa Health Plan Prescription Program Authorization form to Walgreens to have the prescription filled. This program is ONLY for emergency prescriptions.

IV. **PROCEDURES**

- CFS Roles and Responsibilities Α.
 - 1. The CFS worker assigned to the referral/case is responsible for ensuring that a prescription for **EMERGENCY** medication is filled at Walgreens for the child when authorized by a physician.

- 2. If a Medi-Cal card or proof of private health insurance is not available and medication is prescribed after 5:00 PM or on a weekend, CFS staff shall take the prescription, together with Walgreens voucher form (see Attachment 1) to one of the Walgreens Drug Stores listed in Attachment 2. The Walgreens voucher form will contain the Walgreens ID plan code and the last name of the foster child who will be taking the medication. (This information will have to be written in by the Social Worker.)
- 3. CFS staff shall obtain the authorization code by contacting the following CFS personnel: ; East, West and Central County Division Managers, East, West and Central ER Supervisors, Countywide Division Manager, Adoptions/HF Division Manager and the Afterhours ERP Supervisor.
- Whenever use of the pharmacy code is authorized, the authorizing person 4. should go to his/her computer's "G" drive, click on the Walgreens Authorization folder, and enter the following information into the log: Child's Name, Social Worker, Authorizing Individual. and Date Authorized.
- 5. CFS staff will ensure that the medical prescription information filled in by Walgreens is given to the HEP clerk for input into CWS/CMS HEP page.
