

Protocol:

Release of Foster Child's Social Security Number

OVERVIEW

The Department has established a new protocol for releasing a foster child's Social Security Number (SSN). The established protocol protects the foster child's SSN by ensuring the resource parent(s) agrees under order by the Juvenile Court to only use the SSN for the purpose of claiming the foster child on their taxes. **The SSN should not be released for any other purpose** (eg. medical records, mental health services, school enrollment, etc..)

When a resource parent or caregiver requests the SSN of a foster child that is placed in their home please inform them the SSN is **only** to be used to claim the child on their taxes.

PROCEDURES

Primary Social Worker

- STEP 1 Complete an Ex Parte Application requesting the release of the dependent child's SSN. You can use same ex parte for siblings placed in same home. (Please find an example ex parte included below, with approved language in red from County Counsel.) This language can be copied and pasted into your application.
- Next, complete the Order Authorizing Release of Child's Social Security Number to Foster Parent. An example is attached. The form is in CWS under pink tab and green tab (select new document, then 'County' and 'Contra Costa', then Order for SSN Release-see screenshot below).



- **STEP 3** Submit the Ex Parte Application and Order to Court.
- STEP 4 Once you have received the Order Authorizing Release of SSN signed and stamped from the Court you can release the SSN to the resource parent. File both the application and order in the case file.

REASON FOR APPLICATION

The Department requests an order authorizing the social worker to release the child(ren)'s social security number(s) to the foster parent solely for the purpose of complying with IRS requirements to provide the social security number of dependent foster child/ren for whom dependent tax exemption(s) is/are sought.

NOTICES

REASON FOR RECOMMENDATION

The foster parent(s) is/are in need of the child/ren's social security number(s) in order to claim the federal dependent tax exemption on their tax return. In order to release the child(s) social security number, the Department is in need of a court order.

RECOMMENDATION

It is respectfully recommended that the Court issue an order authorizing the release of the social security number of the above named child/ren to the foster parent(s) and limit the use of the released information to the foster parent(s)'s tax returns.
